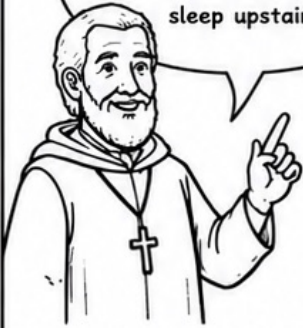


Explore the Brothers' House
